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College of Osteopathic Medicine 2ND Year Health Requirements

Students progressing to their second year in the College of Osteopathic Medicine must have completed their pre-matriculation requirements and additional requirements in preparation for clinical rotations. Information about these requirements are listed below.

- **Annual Physical Examination** – Must be signed and dated by your PCP or medical professional and submitted no later than 12 months from date of last exam. Must use **FORM B**.
- **ACLS Certification** – Students will complete this certification at the end of their second year and may upload this information to their Certified Profile when completed.
- **A 2 step PPD** is required during the end of the second year and will be available during the Student Health PPD event in March or April. The procedure for the required 2 step PPD is as follows:
 - Step 1:** PPD1 is placed on day one then read within 48-72 hours and documented in **mm of induration**.
 - Step 2:** PPD2 is placed **7-18 days after PPD1 is placed** then read within 48-72 hours and documented in **mm of induration**. Both steps (placement and readings) must be completed within **21 days**.
- Students with a history of a positive PPD, submit the following:
 - Annual TB Questionnaire AND
 - A clear chest x-ray report submitted every 2 years.
 - Documentation **MUST** be submitted on the school form available for download.

Students who have not completed their Pre-matriculation Immunizations and Health Requirements may be subject to serious consequences that include inability to attend rotations, and receiving a hold on their registration.
